Surgical wounds and injuries around the perineal, scrotal, coccygeal, anal or vulval area of a patient are very difficult to dress. Typically wounds within these areas are considered by professionals to be difficult to apply conventional dressings to, such as the T-bandage. Such dressings are inefficient as they frequently do not stay in place.



Certain dressings are currently uncomfortable for patients. There is also a difficulty in the selection of the correct size of dressing for a particular patient and a lack of ease in use on patients that are less mobile or even unconscious.



The U-Net® is a versatile uni-sex support dressing that holds surgical dressings in place in the perineal, scrotal, coccygeal, anal or vulval area of a patient and helps to overcome the traditional difficulty in caring for these areas.

The U-Net® support dressing comes in a range of sizes, the design of the product provides for visibility when the need arises to inspect a wound to which a dressing has been applied on a patient. The U-Net® also affords ventilation to the wound area thereby aiding recovery time for the patient.
